Volunteer hours on a project(s) from approved list

Detween 15 and 18 hours of volunteer time should be expected (may be fulfilled by anyone on behalf of each participant)

Can I pay to reduce volunteer hours?

At the rate of \$15 per volunteer hour you may donate

Parents and participants should attend all mandatory or requested meetings personally (no proxy)

Proudly support and promote the show and your hard work

This can include participating in impromptu mall performances, distributing show posters and fliers, social media postings, etc.
