Sinbad assumes the celebration is for him because he is there to tell his stories.	SINBAD: Well, this is quite a welcome celebration for being a "surprise". DOWAGER SULTANESS GULNARE: Oh, no, this is the coronation celebration for my son, Sultan
	Beder. Why would you think it was for you? QUEEN MOTHER DARYA: Yes, why are you here?

	SINBAD: Well, Scheherazade was going to continue with more sea stories; so, obviously, she must have intended to tell my stories.
	KING SALEH: No, she is telling the rest of our story!
	SINBAD: What does that have to do with the sea?
	DOWAGER SULTANESS GULNARE: Well, my people do come from under the sea even though we can live on land just as well.
	KING SALEH: And our story involves two kingdoms from under the sea.
	SINBAD: Yes, but my stories are THE most well known sea stories in the whole 1001 tales that Queen Scheherazade tells to save her life!
	QUEEN MOTHER DARYA: Says you!
	SULTAN BEDER: Look, we can settle this right now. Scheherazade!

	LIGHT CUE:
Scheherazade enters from ship platform to settle the dispute.	SCHEHERAZADE: What is going on here? I am just about to start telling my husband, King Shahriyar, his nightly story. You do remember the consequences if I don't keep him entertained, right?

KING SALEH: Of course, he'll have you beheaded like he did all of the many, many other wives that he has married each day since his first wife cheated on him and he no longer trusted women to be faithful.
SCHEHERAZADE: Yes! And I promised my father that I had a plan that would keep me alive. That's the only reason he allowed me to marry Shahriyar.
CITIZEN STACIE: Who was her father?
CITIZEN DAVID: He was Shahriyar's Grand Vizier who Shahriyar made find a new bride each day even though everyone knew she would meet the same fate after the wedding night. Now, shhh!
SCHEHERAZADE: My plan has been working, too. I tell Shahriyar a new story each night and end in the morning just before getting to a climactic moment. He is so anxious to hear how the story ends that he lets me live another day!
CITIZEN ANNMIREY: Wow, she really risks her life – why?
CITIZEN CARLEEN: She loves the Sultan, who she has known all her life, having grown up in the palace, and she knew he wasn't really a bad person, so she felt she could get him to trust again.
CITIZEN STEPH: Plus, she knew she had to do something to keep more women from being killed.
SCHEHERAZADE: Now what is going on here that is keeping me from starting my story tonight?
SINBAD: Well, you said you would be telling stories of the sea and that must mean my stories, but these delusional people seem to think you are telling their story.
SCHEHERAZADE: They are right.
SINBAD: WHAT?! But my stories are exciting, suspenseful, adventure-filled and thoroughly entertaining.

	SCHEHERAZADE: And, no offense, somewhat repetitive. I mean does a reasonable person go on seven voyages when he gets shipwrecked or left behind each time!
	SINBAD: But, how could the likes of this sad bunch have a story anywhere near as compelling? I mean, my stories are fantastic!
	SCHEHERAZADE: Maybe too fantastic – frankly, we don't have the budget to recreate them on stage. Really, birds as tall as the trees that you tie yourself to the legs of, a village of giant Cyclopes, sea serpents, eagles that lift you up sheer cliffs while strapped to diamond studded meat. How can I possibly create that on this stage?
	SINBAD: If I think of a way, can we tell my story.
	SCHEHERAZADE: Look, the other thing is that your stories lack romance. I like to tell Shahriyar stories of romance with happy endings so that he sees that not all women are untrustworthy. If he learns to trust and love me, I know that I will be safe forever.

	KING SALEH: Mubeenah, I'm glad you were able to come!
	MUBEENAH - ISLAND QUEEN/ORACLE: I really shouldn't have, King Saleh, but you made such an impassioned plea on behalf of your nephew, Sultan Beder, how could I not have come? Who are they?
	KING SALEH: This is Queen Mother Darya from my undersea kingdom of Ardvisura.
	QUEEN MOTHER DARYA: Pleased to meet you.
	KING SALEH: And this is my sister, Dowager Sultaness Gulnare, she is Beder's mother and widow of the late Sultan Wahab.
	DOWAGER SULTANESS GULNARE: So, you now know who we are, but I'm afraid that my brother has shared nothing about you.
	MUBEENAH - ISLAND QUEEN/ORACLE: I am Mubeenah!
	KING SALEH: Mubeenah is an Oracle. I have invited her here to help us identify the perfect bride for Beder - as no Sultan should be without a wife with whom he can share his life and bare an heir to his kingdom; especially not one who is as beloved by the people as Beder is already.
	DOWAGER SULTANESS GULNARE: I, too, hope for those things for my son, but do you think it is wise to meddle with kismet? Aren't such things designed to unfold in their own time?

	MUBEENAH - ISLAND QUEEN/ORACLE: I tried to explain that you must not try to force love to happen, but
	QUEEN MOTHER DARYA: My son can be very insistent!
	MUBEENAH - ISLAND QUEEN/ORACLE: Yes!
	KING SALEH: I wasn't intending to meddle. I merely thought that if we knew who kismet had in store for Beder, then we would be better able to help matters along when destiny chose to make an introduction.
	MUBEENAH - ISLAND QUEEN/ORACLE: I hope so, because if you did interfere I foresee terrible troubles!
	KING SALEH: For Beder?
	MUBEENAH - ISLAND QUEEN/ORACLE: For all of you, but I was thinking more of me if my husband found out!
	KING SALEH: Well, will you help us?
	LIGHT CUE:
She sprinkles a potion into the water and waves her hands over the water.	MUBEENAH - ISLAND QUEEN/ORACLE: Oh , I suppose it wouldn't hurt to at least confirm that destiny does have a perfect girl for Beder and to show you her image.
